Hoffman's 2003 political documentary, "The Party's Over"? Or "OT: Our Town," an Independent Spirit nominee about Compton High School's attempt to put on its first play in 20 years? No, of course you don't - like many smaller indies, these only opened in a few markets. So what's a deprived D.C. cineaste to do? One answer: Join Film Movement (www.filmmovement.com), a DVD club that for \$19.95 a month (or \$199 a year) mails members a lauded-but-tiny movie to own, chosen by a panel of international film festival curators. The DVD -- with added features and a special short -- lands at the same time the film opens commercially; membership also allows you to e-mail the movie's cast and crew.
